ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation and commencement
2. New minimum wages

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs by section 142 of the Employment Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Minimum Wages Order, 1993, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st of April, 1993.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Regulation of Wages (Building, Construction, Exploration and Quarrying Industries) Order, the Regulation of Wages (Wholesale and Retail Distributive Trades) Order, the Regulation of Wages (Manufacturing, Service and Repair Trades) Order, the Regulation of Wages (Hotel, Catering and Entertainment Trades) Order and the Regulation of Wages (Garage, Motor Trade and Road Transport) Order, the basic minimum wages to be paid to employees in the undermentioned trades or industries shall be as indicated in relation thereto, and the Orders mentioned herein shall be deemed to be amended accordingly —
