SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by section 15 of the Statistics Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Statistics (Demographic Survey) (Births, Deaths and Population Movement) Regulations, 2006. Citation
2. The Government Statistician may direct any authorised officer to conduct a survey on the births, deaths and population movements to determine the population age-structure, size, growth, and population distribution at different district and locality levels. Authorisation to conduct a survey
3. The authorised officer may, for the purposes of the survey, interview any person and ask such questions as may be necessary to obtain from that person, the information required in the questionnaires set out in the Schedule. Conduct of survey
4. Any person who refuses or neglects to answer any question put to him or her for purposes of these Regulations commits an offence and is liable to a fine of P50 and in the case of a continuing offence, to a fine of P2 for every day during which the offence continues. Penalty
