| 1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Lobatse Town Council (Operation of Pound) Bye-laws, 2008. | Citation |
| 2. In these Bye-laws, unless the context otherwise requires —
“Council” means the Lobatse Town Council; and
“Township” means Lobatse Township. | Interpretation |
| 3. These Bye-laws shall apply within the limits of the township. | Application |
| 4. The Council shall operate a pound which shall be situated within the limits of the township. | Operation of pound |
| 5. (1) The Council shall appoint a pound master and such other persons as are necessary for the proper conduct of a pound. | Appointment of pound master |
| (2) The pound master shall comply with those provisions of the Pounds Act which are in force within the township. | Cap. 36:05 |
| 6. (1) All moneys received by the pound master in terms of the Pounds Act shall be paid into the funds of the Council. | Financing of pound |
| (2) All costs incurred in operating the pound and all moneys lawfully expended by the pound master shall be defrayed by the Council. | |
