ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Insertion of bye-law 8A of Cap. 40:01 (Sub. Leg.)
3. Amendment of bye-law 9
4. Amendment of First Schedule to the Bye-Laws

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 33 of the Local Government (District Councils) Act, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government, the Council makes the following Bye-Laws —

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Central District Council (Dogs), (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 2012. Citation
2. The Bye-laws are amended by inserting immediately after bye-law 8, the following new bye-law — Insertion of
bye-law 8A
of Cap. 40:01
(Sub. Leg.)
 - “ Appeals 8A. Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Council, made under these Bye-laws may appeal to the Minister within 30 days of notification of that decision.”.
3. The Bye-laws are amended in bye-law 9 by substituting the following new bye-law — Amendment of
bye-law 9 of
Cap. 40:01
(Sub. Leg.)
 - “ Penalties 9. Any person who contravenes the provisions of these Bye-laws commits an offence and is liable —
 - (a) to a fine not exceeding P2000, or in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or to both; and
 - (b) on a second or subsequent conviction to a fine not exceeding P5000, or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years, or to both.”.

4. The First Schedule to the Bye-laws is amended by substituting the following new Schedule —

“FIRST SCHEDULE
(bye-laws 3 (5) and 6 (4))

	Fees
Detention	P10 per day
Licence	P20 per annum
Duplicate licence	P10.”.
