ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation and commencement
2. Amendment of regulation 2 of Cap. 43:08 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Trade and Industry by section 3 (2) (d) of the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation and
commence-
ment

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Intoxicating Liquor (Levy)) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012, and shall come into operation on 1st October, 2012.

Amendment of
regulation 2 of
Cap. 43:08
(Sub. Leg.)

2. Regulation 2 of the Control of Goods (Intoxicating Liquor) (Levy) Regulations, is amended by substituting for regulation 2, the following new regulation —

“Levy on
intoxicating
liquor

2. A person who —
- (a) manufactures intoxicating liquor specified in the Schedule shall pay a levy at a rate of 45 per cent on the cost of production of such goods when sold for home consumption; and
 - (b) imports intoxicating liquor specified in the Schedule shall pay a levy at a rate of 45 per cent on the value.”.
