ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Communications by section 130 of the Road Traffic Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Use of Mobile Phones) (Amendment) Regulations, 2013. Citation

2. The Road Traffic Act (Use of Mobile Phones) Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are amended in regulation 3 (4) by substituting for paragraph (e) the following new paragraph — Amendment
of regulation 3
of Cap. 69:01
(Sub. Leg.)

“(e) he or she was a police officer, a peace officer, a transport inspector, a member of the Botswana Defence Force using a two-way radio while driving a motor vehicle in execution of his or her duties.”.

3. The Regulations are amended by substituting for regulation 4 the following new regulation — Amendment
of regulation 4
of the
Regulations

“4. Any person who contravenes these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence, and liable to a fine not exceeding P500, or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or to both.”.
