Appointment of Session of Parliament

PROCLAMATION

HIS EXCELLENCY LIEUTENANT GENERAL SERETSE KHAMA IAN KHAMA,
PH, FOM, DCO, DSM, MP,
PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF BOTSWANA

WHEREAS it is provided by section 90 (1) of the Constitution of Botswana that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Botswana and shall commence at such time as the President may appoint;

AND WHEREAS it is further provided by section 90 (3) of the Constitution that whenever Parliament is dissolved, a general election of the Elected Members of the National Assembly shall be held within 60 days of the date of the dissolution and a session of Parliament shall be appointed to commence within 30 days of that general election;

AND WHEREAS Parliament was dissolved on the 29th day of August, 2014 and a general election of Elected Members of the National Assembly was held on the 24th day October, 2014;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 90 (1) of the Constitution, I, LIEUTENANT GENERAL SERETSE KHAMA IAN KHAMA, President of the Republic of Botswana, hereby declare, proclaim and make known that a session of Parliament shall be held at the Parliament House, Gaborone, commencing at 14:00 o'clock in the afternoon of the 30th October, 2014.
