SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Finance and Development Planning by section 50 of the Statistics Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Statistics (Information and Communication Technology Survey) Regulations, 2014. Citation
2. The Statistician General may direct any authorised officer to conduct a survey on Information and Communication Technology in Botswana to — Authorisation to conduct survey
 - (a) determine the access and utilisation of Information and Communication Technology services in the country;
 - (b) gather baseline data which will inform formulation of Information and Communication Technology development policies and appropriate strategies for the country;
 - (c) assess the individual's socio-demographic characteristics as well as access to and usage of Information and Communication Technology at individual level; and
 - (d) assess the socio-economic and demographic characteristics of a household, its access to Information and Communication Technology and also identify the members of that household that are eligible for further interview.
3. The authorised officer may, for the purposes of the survey, ask any person interviewed such questions as may be necessary to obtain, from that person, the information required in the questionnaires set out in the Schedule. Conduct of survey
4. Any person who refuses or neglects to answer any question put to him or her for the purposes of these Regulations commits an offence and is liable to a fine of P100.00, and in the case of a continuing offence, to a fine of P5.00 for every day during which the offence continues. Penalty
