ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Amendment of bye-law 10 of the Bye-laws

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by sections 44 and 45 of the Local Government Act, and after consultation with the community living within the council area, and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government and Rural Development, the South East District Council hereby makes the following Bye-laws —

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the South East District Council Citation
(Noise and Nuisance)(Amendment) Bye-Laws, 2015.

2. The South East District Council (Noise and Nuisance) Bye-laws are Amendment of
amended by substituting for bye-law 10 therein the following new bye-law — bye-law 10 of
the Bye-laws

“Penalties 10. Any person who fails to comply with these Bye-laws commits an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding P500 or, in default thereof, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 21 days, and on a second or subsequent conviction, to a fine not exceeding P2 000 or, in default thereof, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding four months.”.
