ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Rectification of error in Act No. 9 of 2018

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Law Revision Commissioner by section 12 of the Revision of the Laws Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Rectification of the Laws (Counter-Terrorism (Amendment) Act) Order, 2018. Citation
2. The errors appearing in the Counter-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2018 are rectified in — Rectification of error in Act No. 9 of 2018
 - (a) in section 2 (f) by substituting for the definition of “funds”, the following new definition —
““funds” means assets of any kind, whether corporeal or incorporeal, tangible or intangible, movable or immovable, however acquired, and legal documents or instruments in any form, including electronic or digital, evidencing title to, or interest in such assets;”;
 - (b) in section 4 by substituting for paragraph (d), the following new paragraph —
“(d) by substituting for subsection (4), the following new subsection —
“(4) For an act or omission to constitute an offence under this section, it is not necessary that the property was actually used, in full or in part to carry out an act of terrorism or that an act of terrorism has been committed.”; and
 - (c) in section 8 by substituting for subsection (1), the following new subsection —
“13. (1) A person who —
 - (a) knowingly forms, owns or becomes a terrorist or a member of a terrorist group;
 - (b) professes to be a terrorist or a member of a terrorist group; or
 - (c) invites or solicits another person to become a terrorist or a member of a terrorist group,commits an offence and is liable to a term of imprisonment for life, or to a fine of P5 000 000.00 or to both.”.
