IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President of the Republic of Botswana by section 3 (4) as read with section 3 (5) of the Extradition Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (The United Arab Emirates) Order, 2018. Citation
2. The Extradition Act shall apply between Botswana and the United Arab Emirates with respect to surrendering of any fugitive criminal, subject to the conditions, exceptions or qualification as are specified under paragraph 3 of this Order. Application of the Act in the case of the United Arab Emirates
3. (1) The crimes which shall be deemed to be extradition crimes for the purposes of this Order and the Act shall be crimes which — Extradition crimes
 - (a) in terms of the laws of the requesting country, are subject to the jurisdiction of that requesting country's highest court of appeal in criminal matters; and
 - (b) are punishable, both under the laws of the requesting country and of the requested country, by imprisonment for a maximum period of at least two years or by some more severe penalty.
- (2) Where a sentence has been imposed after conviction in respect of a crime referred to in subparagraph (1), extradition shall be granted irrespective of the nature or period of the punishment imposed.
