ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation and Commencement
2. Amendment of Schedules to Cap. 38:01 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Environment, Natural Resources Conservation and Tourism by section 92 of the Wildlife Conservation and National Parks Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wildlife Conservation and National Parks (Hunting and Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021, and shall come into operation on 1st April, 2022.
