1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods, Prices and Other Charges (Restriction on Importation of Wheat Flour) Regulations, 2021.	Citation
2. For the purposes of these Regulations, "authorized officer" means the officer in the Ministry responsible for trade who is charged with the responsibility of issuing permits for the importation of wheat flour into Botswana.	Person authorized to issue permits
3. (1) No person shall import wheat flour except under and in accordance with a written permit issued under these Regulations. (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subregulation (1), an import permit shall not be required from any person who imports wheat flour of an amount not exceeding 12,5kg, for his personal consumption.	Restriction on importation of wheat flour
4. An application for a permit to import wheat flour shall be made to the authorized officer, and such application shall contain such information, and shall be accompanied by such documents, as may be specified by the authorized officer.	Application for import permit
5. Where the authorized officer is satisfied that an applicant for a permit under regulation 4 is a fit and proper person and that such person has complied with all the conditions specified for the issue of a permit he may authorize such person to import wheat flour on such conditions as may be specified in the permit.	Issue of Import
6. Any person aggrieved by the refusal of the authorized officer to issue him with an import permit under these Regulations may appeal to the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry whose decision thereon shall be final.	Appeals against refusal to issue permit
7. Any person who imports any wheat flour into Botswana without an import permit or contravenes any provision contained in the permit issued to him shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction thereof shall be liable to penalties prescribed in section of the Act.	Penalties
8. The Control of Goods (Restriction on Importation of Wheat Flour) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021 are hereby revoked.	Revocation of S.I. No. 40 of 1985
