An Act to amend the Specified Offices (Salaries and Allowances) Act.

Date of Assent: 05.12.2022

Date of Commencement: ON PUBLICATION

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Specified Offices (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 2022, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April, 2022.

Short title and commencement

2. The Specified Offices (Salaries and Allowances) Act (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) is amended by substituting for section 3, the following new section —

Amendment of section 3 of Cap. 26:04

3. The Chairman of a Delimitation Commission shall be paid a duty allowance of P2 250 per day, including the day on which the Commission’s report is delivered to the President.”

3. The Act is amended by substituting for section 4, the following new section —

Amendment of section 4 of the Act

4. A member of a Delimitation Commission (other than the Chairman) shall be paid a duty allowance of P1 800 per day, including the day on which the Commission’s report is delivered to the President.”

4. The Act is amended by substituting for the Schedule thereto, the following new Schedule —

Amendment of Schedule to the Act

Other Members of the Public Service Commission	–	At the rate of P73,014.48 per annum;

Auditor-General	–	At the rate of P715,950.14 per annum;
Secretary to the Independent Electoral Commission	–	At the rate of P715,950.14 per annum;
Director of Public Prosecutions	–	At the rate of P628,084.80 per annum.”.
