IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Communications by section 28 of the Road Transport (Permits) Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

| Amendment of Third Schedule to Cap. 69:03 (Sub. Leg.) | 2. The Road Transport (Permits) Regulations are amended by substituting for the Third Schedule, the following new Schedule — |

**“THIRD SCHEDULE**  
**TOKENS FOR PERMITS**

(Regulation 9)

1. In connection with the issue of BA, BS, TA, TS and P permits under the Act, tokens as described in paragraphs 4 and 5 hereunder shall be issued to the permit holders, one for every vehicle operated under the permit.
2. The tokens shall bear the same serial numbers as their corresponding permits.
3. The token shall be attached to the vehicle so that the inscription is clearly legible to a person standing in front and to the left of the vehicle, and if the vehicle is fitted with a transparent windscreen, the token shall be affixed in an upright position on the inside of the windscreen.
4. The token shall indicate the type of permits by the letters BA, BS, TA, TS or P, as the case may be and the last two digits of the last year of the validity of the permit.
5. The token shall be printed on a security paper in the shape of an isosceles triangle measuring 12,5 x 12,5 x 12 cm, containing the information as indicated in the following diagram
