SCHEDULES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Minerals and Energy by section 72 A of the Botswana Energy Regulatory Authority Act, and after consultation with the Authority, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Botswana Energy Regulatory Authority (Quota Allocation) Order, 2023 and shall come into operation on the 1st April, 2024. Citation and commencement
2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires — Interpretation
 - “import quantity” means the quantities of petroleum products imported for consumption in Botswana in any given year;
 - “public body” means Botswana Oil Limited;
 - “Petroleum products quota allocation” means the percentage of import quantity of petroleum product, allocated for importation by Botswana Oil Limited;
3. (1) There is established a percentage of the import quantity to be known as petroleum products quota allocation. Petroleum products quota allocation
 - (2) The petroleum products quota allocation shall be imported by Botswana Oil Limited.
 - (3) The petroleum products Quota Allocation shall be as set out in the Schedule.
