PUBLIC ROADS (GRANT OF WAYS OF NECESSITY) ORDER, 2024

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Grant of ways of necessity

IN EXERCISE of powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Public Works by section 4 of the Public Roads Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Roads (Grant of Ways of Necessity) Order, 2024. Citation

2. (1) The ways of roads of necessity described in the Schedule hereto are granted as ways or roads of necessity. Grant of ways of necessity

(2) The width and direction of each way or road of necessity under subparagraph (1) shall be as appears in the drawings deposited by the applicants with the Director of Surveys and Lands.

SCHEDULE

The Minister grants authority to —

- (a) Ace Team (Pty) Ltd for a proposed access, all movement for a proposed commercial Plot Nos. 17170 and 17171, along A12/2 road in Molepolole as per submission referenced AC004/24, dated 10th May, 2024 and drawings No. PAL-003023, REV P0 for Franaco (Pty) Ltd;
- (b) Botswana Power Corporation for road reserve occupation by 33KV OH Powerline (35km) along A3 road (Gantsi-Junction 44 road) and 1 No. crossing (A3) at Junction 44 and 33KV OH Powerline along A2 road (Junction 44 to km 9 towards Chobokwane) and No. 1 crossing (A2) towards Botswana Oil Depot as per submission dated 20th May, 2024 and drawings titled 33KV OHL to Botswana Oil Limited Strategic Storage Depot amended 25th June, 2024, for Botswana Oil Strategic Storage Depot. The developer must do underground crossings across (A3 road) and (A2 road); and
- (c) Ace Team (Pty) Ltd for a proposed road access, all movement junction for a proposed filing station on Tribal Lot No. 1407 along A1 road in Dinokwe/ Palla Road, as per submission referenced AC004/19, dated 24th November, 2023 and drawings No. DNK-003, REV 0 dated May, 2024 for Kagiso Onkemetse Mokubung.
