ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation and commencement
2. Amendment of regulation 2 of Cap. 43:02 (Sub. Leg.)
3. Amendment of regulation 34 of the Regulations

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Trade and Industry by section 31 of the Trade Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Trade (Amendment) Regulations, 2024, and shall come into operation on 15th February, 2025. Citation and commencement

2. The Trade Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are amended in regulation 2 by inserting, immediately after the definition of “toy shop”, the following new definition — Amendment of regulation 2 of Cap. 43:02 (Sub. Leg.)

““tswana food item” means cooked traditional tswana meals including samp (*setampa*), sorghum (*mabele*), millet (*lebelebele*), fat cakes (*magwinya*), mophane worm (*phane*), chicken feet (*menoto*), chicken hearts, chicken necks, chicken heads, *phaphatha*, tripe (*serobe*), and pounded meat (*seswaa*);”.

3. Regulation 34 is amended by substituting for the regulation, the following new regulation — Amendment of regulation 34 of the Regulations

“Takeaway licence 34. (1) The Director shall not issue a takeaway licence to an applicant unless such applicant’s premises have —

(a) an oil and water separator trap; and

(b) a kitchen facility.

(2) An applicant who is a medium or a large enterprise, and has been issued with a takeaway licence, shall not sell any tswana food item.”.
