PUBLIC ROADS (GRANT OF WAYS OF NECESSITY) ORDER, 2025
(Published on 18th July, 2025)

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Grant of ways of necessity

IN EXERCISE of powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure by section 4 of the Public Roads Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Roads (Grant of Ways of Necessity) Order, 2025. Citation

2. (1) The ways of roads of necessity described in the Schedule hereto are granted as ways or roads of necessity. Grant of ways of necessity

(2) The width and direction of each way or road of necessity under subparagraph (1) shall be as appears in the drawings deposited by the applicant with the Director of Surveys and Lands.

SCHEDULE

The Minister grants authority to —

- (a) **Morapedi Masake** for the proposed reserve occupation by 75mm pipe sleeve to accommodate 50mm HDPE underground pipe across A20 road at Makopong. The recommendation is based on the applicant letter dated 10th March, 2020 and Tsabong District Coordinator correspondence ref: SWR 110 IV (52) dated 24th February, 2025, sketch plan and cross section drawings for Morapedi Masake;
- (b) **Botswana Power Cooperation** for the proposed reserve occupation 33Kv overhead power line (5.46 Kilometers) along A2 road at Chobokwane. The recommendation is based on submission referenced 0005094209 dated 27th March 2025 and drawings No: RD/33/06/24 REV: A Sheet 1-3 for Botswana Power Corporation;
- (c) **MSR Consult (Pty) Ltd** for the proposed all-movement access road into a proposed agricultural mixed development plot (abattoir), at Mohembo, Botswana along A35 road. The recommendation is based on the submission referenced FM/RD/03-25(iii) dated 26 March 2025, drawings No: MSR/FM24/001 Rev:3 dated 27/03/2025, No: MSR/FM24/002 Rev:2, dated 27/03/2025, No: MSR/FM24/003 Rev:2 dated 27/03/2025, No: MSR/FM24/004 Rev:3 dated 27/03/2025 and No: MSR/FM24/005 Rev:1 dated 11/02/2025 for Farm Meat (Pty) Ltd;
- (d) **Jindal Energy Botswana** for the proposed upgrading of Capricorn Jindal Mmamabula Road (24km). The recommendation is based on the submission referenced BL485/JEB/PACKAGE A07/003 dated 13th March, 2025 and a book of drawings dated March 2025 for Jindal Energy Botswana;
- (e) **Liquid Intelligent Technology** for the proposed road reserve occupation by underground fibre cable (2700m) and one (1) underground road crossing on A1 Road at Lobatse. The recommendation is based on submission referenced 03_1/2025/LITB dated 25th March, 2025, drawing No: DZE-RYL-LOB-4325 dated 7th April, 2025 for Liquid Intelligent Technology;

- (f) Jindal Energy Botswana for the proposed reserve occupation 33Kv overhead power line (3.250 Kilometers) along B142 road. The recommendation is based on submission dated 19th March 2025, referenced JMEP/DPR/19/3/25 I and correspondence about the 15m wide Wayleave from Landboard ref: MSLB/6/3/15 II (5) dated 9th January 2025 and drawing Number: JMEP/JEB/01-C001 REV: A dated 05/08/2024, drawing No: JMEP-JEB-01-C0125 REV: B dated 20/02/2025, drawing No: JMEP/JEB/05-E0102 REV: A dated 30/08/2024 and drawing No: JMEP/JEB/05-E0101 REV: dated 30/08/2024 for Jindal Energy Botswana (Pty) Ltd;
- (g) Scales Associates for the proposed road reserve occupation by 11Kv overhead power line (2.324 Kilometers) and one (1) underground road crossing along B111 road. The recommendation is based on submission referenced WUC 307-1/BTB/Roads lps dated 18th March, 2025 and drawings No: MOL/WUC008-21/WWTP-003 Rev:1/1 dated 19/09/2024 and drawings No: MOL/WUC008-21/WWTO-001 Rev:3 sheets 1-2 dated March 2025 for Water Utilities Cooperation; and
- (h) William Lee Associates for the proposed relocation of the approved all-movement junction into a proposed filling station and Truck Inn onto plot Z4162, along A12 Road, Tlokweng. The recommendation is based on the submission referenced 21005/J/DW/250088 dated 02 May 2025 and drawings No: 601 Rev: E dated 23.04.25 for Tswana Fuel (Pty) Ltd.
